# 1. Sede judicial electrónica

*Sede judicial electrónica* is an electronic judicial office that offers all judicial digital services from the Ministry. *Carpeta Justicia* will connect all judicial digital services within Spain.

- [Sede judicial electrónica](#) is the website where information and services for citizens, justice professionals, companies and other organizations are gathered. It works as a gateway for justice digital services.
- Examples of services:
  - **Citizens/companies/other organizations:**
    - Presentation of documents to courts (e.g. small claim requests)
    - Electronic apud acta = granting of a power of attorney
  - **Justice professionals:**
    - Access to the electronic court file (new service, being implemented)
    - Presentation of an expert opinion requested by the court
  - **All interested users:**
    - Consultation of judicial proceedings (e.g. court hearing)

Coming soon: 2023 (Next Gen EU)

## Carpeta Justicia (Justice Folder)

- There are several “sede judicial electronica” (one for each Autonomous Community having competencies)
- Carpeta Justicia will offer information and access to all digital justice services within Spain.

**LexNET is the most used application to communicate justice professionals with courts in both senses.  
CITIUS will connect all communication systems within Spain.**

- **LexNET makes digital communication possible:**
  - **From justice professionals to courts**
    - Sending of documents
  - **From courts to justice professionals**
    - Notifications and notices
    - Service of documents
  - **Between courts and public administrations / police & security forces / hospitals / ...**
    - Requesting reports from a court / sending of reports from administrations
    - Sending police reports or hospital reports to court
- **LexNET can be accessed in several modes:**
  - Web application
  - Web services
  - Desktop application
  - Mobile phone application (*coming soon*)
  - Hermes (from hospitals and some police & security forces)

**Coming soon: 2023-25 (Next Gen EU)**

**CITIUS: A common electronic communication system**

- There are **several communication systems** (some Autonomous Communities only use LexNET for some communications).
- CITIUS will try to **connect most of the judicial digital communication systems** within Spain.
- A **map to track the status of electronic communications** within Spain is being drawn.

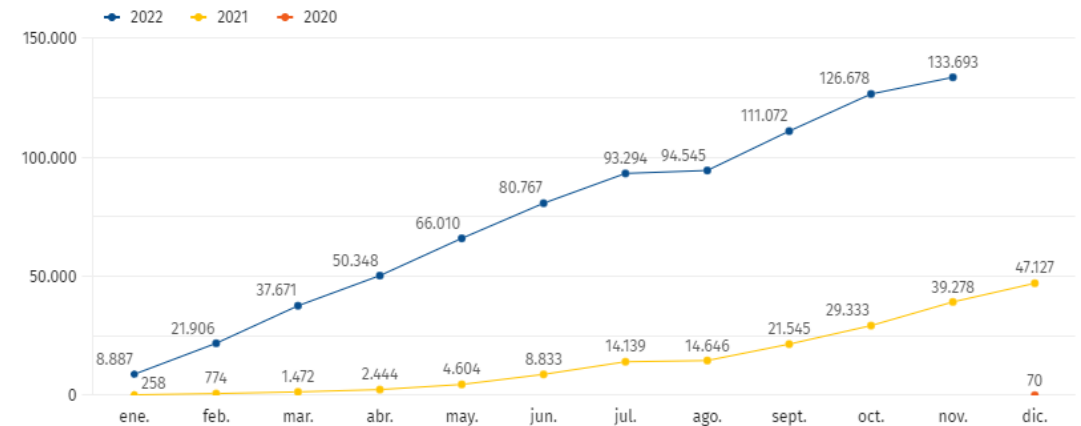

The Digital Services Portal offers services to professionals such as the request of copies of electronic judicial files. More than 180.000 requests have been received since 2021.

- The [Digital Services Portal](#) (or ACCEDA) is a system which is mainly used to offer services to professionals.
- It has been built reusing one of the most common administrative procedure management systems.
- Some services that are offered
  - Request of a copy of the electronic judicial file
  - Sending of large files to court by professionals (from 30 MB to 4 GB)
- Some Autonomous Communities are already using or planning to use these services in SaaS mode.
